Beginners Course Application

Six Villages Archery Club meets every Sunday at 9:00am, at the Six Villages Sports Centre, within the Ormiston Six Villages Academy at Westergate.

See our website www.SixVillageArcheryClub.org.uk for full details.

Passing a recognised beginners course is a prerequisite to becoming a member of the club if you are not already an archer (who will have a previous beginner's course certificate or AGB/GNAS card).

- » The next course is on Saturday 28th and Sunday 29th September 2019.
 - The last date for receiving an application with fee is Wednesday 25th September 2019.
 - A full refund will be offered if the course is cancelled by SVAC.
 - A refund will be given if the applicant cancels before 21st Sept.
 - A deferment to the next course will be offered if the applicant informs SVAC between 21st and 27th September that they wish to defer. The fee will not be refunded if the applicant is not able to make the next course.
 - No refunds or deferment if SVAC are not informed of wish to cancel by 27th September.
- » The course costs:
 - £60 for juniors (under 18), seniors (65 and over) and disabled.
 - £80 for everyone not in the above categories.
- » The course will take place on the field behind the Sports Centre
 - Directions are on the web site www.sixvillagesarcheryclub.org.uk/directions.php.
- » The course runs for the two full days from 9:30am until 4:30pm
- » Courses are run by experienced, qualified coaches and all equipment is provided.
- » There are 12 places available on the course and places are allocated on a first come first served basis.
- » If you join SVAC following the course you will be able to continue to borrow equipment for a period of 6 weeks on payment of a deposit.

Please note that we have a minimum age of 10 years (on the date of the course) for juniors and that for all those aged 13 years or younger, a parent or guardian must be present on the field for the entire course. Also, the requirement for a parent or guardian to be present will continue if the junior subsequently joins Six Villages Archery Club.

Beginners Course Application

Places will be allocated upon receiving course fees. You will be notified when you have been allocated a place.

Please note the following:

- » Smoking (including e-cigarettes and “vaping”) is NOT permitted anywhere on the Ormiston Six Villages Academy grounds.
- » No dogs are allowed except for assistance dogs.
- » The course is run outside. Therefore:
 - Suitable footwear will be required, for example, waterproof shoes or trainers.
 - Please note that flip-flops, sandals or other open shoes **ARE NOT** to be worn at any time.
 - In extreme weather waterproofs or sun hat/sun screen may be required. The course will not stop for the weather unless there is lightning involved.
 - You will need a chair to sit on.
 - Note picnic rugs will not be suitable if it's wet.
 - Multiple thin layers of clothing are preferable to thick ones.
- » Long hair should be tied back (or bring something to tie it back).
- » Facial piercings may need to be removed.
- » Tops should not be baggy or have “strings”.
- » You will need to bring your own packed lunch and drinks.
- » A notebook and pen will be needed.
